

This download file contains a PKCS #7 certificate (.spc) and its complementary private key file (.pvk) for use in signing drivers and/or .CABs for installation on our Windows Mobile based devices.

By default, Windows Mobile security policies are configured to not allow unsigned drivers to run. Because of the HDK and other third party drivers that can be installed on our device, we have changed the default to allow unsigned drivers to run.

However, the security subsystem starts up with default values until it reads the configuration (where we allow for unsigned drivers). This happens later in the boot sequence, after built-in drivers are loaded.

Because of this, third party drivers developed outside of Psion won't be able to load on system startup unsigned.

Thus, if you need a driver to load on system startup on a Psion device specifically, you may use the attached certificates (for Psion devices *only*).

If you want the .CAB to run on any device (not just Psion), then you'll need to get the .CAB signed via an appropriate signing authority (e.g. Verisign).
